Go onto Schools 360 and access SCRATCH. Pupils have been using this in school and can pick a programming activity to try.



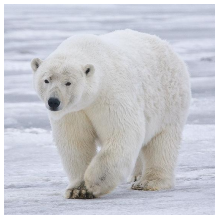
RE
